This is a part-time, salaried position requiring approximately 15 hours of work per week.

- Commitment to supporting the United Methodist Church and a church that is inclusive of all people
- Commitment to a lifestyle of personal spiritual growth
- Approaches their position as a ministry, not just a job
- Operates with a ministry philosophy where staff not only fulfill specific ministry functions, but also develop, equip and mobilize others
- Participates fully in the essential life of the church through regular worship attendance, committed prayer, spiritual formation, servant ministry, generous giving and community outreach

Primary Responsibilities:

- Works with the lead pastor and staff to design, develop and plan weekly worship experiences
- Selects relevant and message-appropriate music for the contemporary worship experience at Milford First, outdoor worship events, and all other services and events, as needed
- Coordinates selected music and lyrics with the director of digital and community engagement
- Recruits, trains and leads a team of worship musicians
- Coordinates all scheduling of praise band members (including sound team)
- Ensures leadership coverage for weekly praise band rehearsals and services
- Maintains awareness of status of church-owned musical equipment and makes recommendations to church leadership on additional or changing needs

- Maturity of Christian character and gifts for ministry
- Excellent ability to lead music ministry teams
- Very reliable and trustworthy
- Spiritual discernment and commitment to prayer
- Willingness and passion for sharing Jesus' message and God's love with others

- Commitment to team-based ministry
- Recruits, trains and develops additional and/or replacement musicians and singers on an ongoing basis

- Ability to prepare and organize necessary music for singers and instrumentalists
