

# Fund Receives New Life with New Congregation

In 1995, Beulah Davis of Plain City, OH

chose to put her faith in the future and make a planned gift with the West Ohio Conference Council on Development in honor of her parents Paul and Lucile Davis. The gift was to benefit their church, Plain City UMC, specifically for maintenance of the building or parsonage. Unfortunately, the church closed some years ago and since that time the gift that was made to the COD became dormant.

"We wanted to put those funds to use, but in situations like these, we have limited options," explained United Methodist Foundation of West Ohio Executive Director, Susan Black. "Since the original donor is deceased, and it is impossible to meet her original intent, and the amount is under \$20,000 and over 20 years old, we sought permission from the Ohio Attorney General to use the funds for a purpose that is closest to the donors' original intent."

That purpose is the maintenance of the church or parsonage for the newly formed Beloved UMC in Marysville, OH. "We're delighted that we can make a grant for the full amount of the fund to help Beloved cover anticipated capital costs and free up current dollars for operating purposes, "said Black.

Beloved UMC will receive a grant of approximately \$15,000 from the Foundation this month and has pledged to uphold the original intent of the donor as closely as possible.

"Donor intent is important," said Black. "In fact, it's the bedrock of our work because if donors don't trust that we will be good stewards of their gifts, they won't give. While this is an unusual case for the Foundation, it's resulted in new life for this new congregation, and we couldn't be more pleased with that outcome. We hope Ms. Davis would agree."

#### **Racial/Ethic Local Church Grant Applications**

The 2024 Racial/Ethnic Local Church(RELC) Grant and the Annual Conference Multiethnic Ministries Grant applications are now available! RELC Grant and Multiethnic Ministries Grant applications will be accepted January 2 – March 1, 2024. Application forms can be found here: <u>https://umcmission.org/multiethnic-ministries/</u>

RELC Grants are provided to assist local racial/ethnic congregations with projects and programs on one of three areas: 1) Leadership Development; 2) Church Growth and Development; and 3) Pastoral Salary Support. The maximum RELC programmatic grant is \$15,000 and the maximum pastoral salary support grant is \$12,000. The church's membership must be at least 51% majority racial/ethnic.

Multiethnic Ministries Grants are provided to annual conferences to assist with programs focusing on racial-ethnic leadership development and racial/ethnic church growth and development.

## Basic & Recert ERT Classes to be offered January 13 in Columbus

UMCOR's Early Response Team (ERT) Basic class will be offered on Saturday, January 13, 8:00 am-4:00 pm at North Broadway UMC in Columbus. A four-hour recertification class will also be offered. West Ohio ERT trainers will teach participants how to assist survivors of natural disasters in their time of need. Trainees will learn how to provide a caring, Christian presence while taking steps to prevent further damage to the family's personal property. Skills that are taught include tarping, debris removal, mucking out flooded homes, etc. FEMA recognizes this training to enter a disaster scene. A background check is required, and a link to complete this will be provided upon registration. **Bryan Stevenson of "Just Mercy" Leadership Clinic March 11 - Online** Bryan Stevenson, founder and Executive Director of the Equal Justice Initiative (EJI), a human rights organization will be the featured guest for Bishop Palmer's Leadership Clinic on March 11, 2024.

Under his leadership, EJI has won major legal challenges eliminating excessive and unfair

sentencing, exonerating innocent death row prisoners, confronting abuse of the incarcerated and the mentally ill, and aiding children prosecuted as adults. Mr. Stevenson has received over 50 honorary doctoral degrees and numerous awards.

He is the author of the critically acclaimed New York Times bestseller, Just Mercy, which was named by Time Magazine as one of the ten Best Books of the year. Just Mercy was adapted as a major motion picture. Mr. Stevenson is also the subject of the Emmy Award-winning HBO documentary True Justice. He is a graduate of the Harvard Law School and the Harvard School of Government.

## Resources

#### It's Time for Clergy W-2's!

2023 W-2's are due to all employees by January 31, 2024. Information to help with preparing IRS Form W-2 for clergy, which can be complicated, can be found on the <u>Conference Website Here</u>. Use the worksheet and example as a guide for preparing your pastor's W-2. This sample spreadsheet and W-2 is just that, a sample. Your fact set may include more or fewer items to report (for example, moving expenses that are now

taxable if paid or reimbursed are not in the sample).

Highlights and guidance for 2023 W-2 preparation:

• Report Housing Exclusion resolutions amounts only as information in Box 14. Do not report cash housing allowance.

• Do not report the cost of the Conference health insurance policy in Box 12.

• W-2 Boxes 3-6 should be blank for clergy; churches should never withhold for Social Security or Medicare for credentialed clergy.

• Moving expenses paid by churches directly to moving companies or via reimbursement to clergy are taxable and must be reported as income and included in box 1 (see the moving expense section of IRS instructions completing W-2's <u>here</u>).

• If your pastor received health insurance through the Conference Plan (Anthem) they received a contribution to their HSA account that should be reported. Clergy on single plans received \$500 in January and July 2023 for a total of \$1,000. Clergy on Family-2 or Family-3 plans received \$1,000 in January and July 2023 for a total of \$2,000. If two churches share in the cost of health insurance, adjust accordingly.

• All full-time clergy and some <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>-time clergy receive a \$50,000 death benefit through a conference plan. This is in addition to \$50,000 available through the denominational plan (CPP). The cost of group life insurance over \$50,000 is taxable. To calculate the amount. click here <u>IRS Publication 15-B</u> and go to page 14. Using your clergy's age, take the corresponding cost and multiply by 50. That is the monthly amount. Multiply by 12 for the yearly total. This is letter "H" on the fact pattern example W-2.

• Note: If your pastor is not on the Conference health insurance plan and your church has not established its own qualified plan, direct payments to clergy to offset the cost of health insurance (for example on a spouse or other employer plan) are taxable income.

The resources referenced here and on the Conference website should answer most of your questions. However, contact your payroll provider, a CPA, or tax preparer if you have technical questions.
