Regional Charge Conferences

You will need to have a Church Council/ Leadership Team/ Administrative Board meeting to complete all work *before* attending your regional Charge Conference. (Note that you do *not* need to secure an Elder to preside at this meeting.) You must also complete the online Charge Conference forms *before* attending your regional Charge Conference (or on paper forms, if you are unable to use online forms). Each church should bring with them copies of the following approved and uploaded forms, which will be received and blessed during worship:

- o Lay Leadership Nominations
- o Ministry Recommendations, if any
- o 2024 Pastor Compensation Report
- Signature Page signifying that the Church Council/ Board/ Leadership Team has voted and approved <u>all</u> charge conference forms and that they have been completed online

All other items/forms which were cared for at your Church Council/Leadership Team meeting should **not** be brought forward at the Charge Conference but **should be entered/uploaded online**.

Note that these four regional Charge Conferences (see bottom of page) are *your* annual charge conference, so use these regional charge conference dates in your paperwork. You and your church leaders are to attend, and please invite all church members to attend with you. This should be a celebration of ministry!

What do you need to do to get ready for charge conferences?

- Start your nominations/lay leadership team meetings soon to fill your committee positions for 2024.
- Meet with your S/PPRC to decide upon the pastoral compensation for 2024, including your housing
- allowance (if applicable), accountable reimbursement, and housing allowance exclusion amounts.
- Meet with your leadership board/team to determine your Breakthrough Goals for 2024.
- Review your membership lists to compose first and second year reading lists for removal from the church rolls.
- Make sure you have an updated Safe Sanctuary Policy. Note that the Pastor, Trustee Chair and S/PPRC Chair will all need to sign your Safe Sanctuary Policy Review form.

Let the Trustee Chair know that if they have not yet done it this year, they should complete the <u>Trustee</u> <u>Legal and Property Report</u>. And if the church has a parsonage and the Trustees have not done the parsonage inspection this year, they should do the <u>parsonage inspection</u> along with a representative from the S/PPRC committee.

Determine if your church has any candidates for ministry or certified lay servants, lay speakers, or certified lay ministers who must be approved at your charge conference. If so, have your laity complete and submit their annual report.

Complete your charge conference forms online, if possible. Online submission can be started by your designated 'Church Data Administrator' and by all pastors. If you need assistance with this process, contact the District Office. Online Submission Process: The online charge conference forms for your church can be found at www.westohioumc.org. Log in. If you cannot remember your login information contact the District Office, do not create a new account as you will not have the right permissions. Once you log in, click on My Church, then Local Church Reports, Charge Conference, 2024. You may want to have your church leadership sign-off on the completed forms electronically. If they need help logging in or accessing the forms they need to sign have them contact the District Office. In order to print out completed forms, go to "View all Forms" at the bottom of the charge conference dashboard. There you can download the set of completed forms to a PDF that you can save to your computer, then print any pages that you need.
