


Bishop's Summer Reading List is Here!

Bridges Out of Poverty Virtual Cohort Beginning September- Wednesdays

This cohort hosted by Missions and Community Engagement in the East Ohio Conference of the UMC will begin this fall! This is an in depth book study of the 5th Edition Bridges out of Poverty Strategies for Professionals and Communities. Participants will meet
