John Wesley UMC Helps Restore Community Pool

The John Wesley United Methodist Church in Cincinnati has had a long-standing relationship with the Pleasant Run Farms Civic Association (PRFCA). During an October 2022 meeting, PRFCA described a huge issue with their swim club. The 50+ year-old complex was dealing with deteriorating concrete and plumbing issues that threatened



the viability of keeping the pools open and they didn't have the needed skills to address the issues. They were certain they'd have to close within the year.

The community was formed before the HOA era, so they had no revenue stream to pay for needed repairs. One vendor had indicated that full restoration could easily reach \$150,000, but he doubted contractors would even bid on the project given the limited access to the pool area and the age of the pools.



As a result, the PRFCA asked if there was any way that John Wesley UMC could help, if just to keep the pool open for one last season. The church responded that they would not only help, but also co-lead the effort! The rest, as they say, is history but not after thousands of dollars and volunteer hours and more obstacles than the church volunteers could have imagined.

Urban Ministry Pop Up Shop is this Saturday


